

Weyerhaeuser Recreational Access Guidelines

Weyerhaeuser currently allows public access to our forestland, while making sure we can work safely, prevent damage to the environment, and safeguard company property. For current specific access information please call the Recreational Access Hotline for Weyerhaeuser in Oregon at **1-888-741-5403**.

The following rules are in effect at the **Coos Bay** location which includes the **Millicoma** tree farm:

- Please, obey all posted signs.
- No littering or garbage dumping.
- No fires at any time, even during hunting season.
- Non-motorized access such as hiking, horseback riding, and biking may be allowed during daylight hours as directed on the Recreational Access Hotline (number listed above).
- Motorized vehicle access may be allowed please refer to the Recreational Access Hotline (number listed above).
- No smoking outside of vehicles.
- No camping at any time, even during hunting season.
- No ATV's or motorcycles at any time.
- No Off-Road driving; stay on improved roads and on your side of the road.
- Use headlights and seatbelts at all times while traveling.
- Speed limit is 35 MPH unless otherwise posted or if driving and/or weather conditions require a reduction in speed.
- Do not block gates with vehicles. Vehicles blocking gates can/will be towed at owner's expense.
- No firewood cutting or removal of forest product/floral greenery without applicable permit (see details below).
- No weapons (except for those used legally for in-season hunting)
- No illegal drug use.
- No alcohol use.
- Report illegal activities to local law enforcement.
- Report vandalism and dumping activity to **541-269-9336**.

Fee Permitted Access:

- Firewood permits issued during winter months, available at the Dellwood Office
- Mushroom permits issued in season, available at the Dellwood Office
- Brush permits issued in season, available at the Dellwood Office
- Fishing passes issued during steelhead season, available at the T-n-T Market and Airport Heights Market
