

Weyerhaeuser Recreational Access Guidelines

Weyerhaeuser provides as many public access opportunities as possible, while ensuring a safe workplace for our employees and contractors, protecting the environment, and safeguarding company property. The following rules are in effect at the [Longview](#) location which includes the [St. Helens](#) tree farm:

1. When access is allowed, all access areas are day-use only and are open one hour before official sunrise and closed one hour after official sunset.
2. Do not enter active work sites.
3. Please, obey all posted signs.
4. No littering or garbage dumping.
5. No fires at any time, even during hunting season.
6. No smoking outside of vehicles.
7. Fireworks of any kind are prohibited.
8. No camping at any time, even during hunting season.
9. All public access to the St. Helens Tree Farm is contingent upon fire danger and the safety of our company and contract forestry and harvesting operations.
10. Roads and areas open for recreational use are subject to immediate closure in response to vandalism, theft and garbage dumping incidents.
11. Vehicles on Weyerhaeuser roads have to be licensed and "highway legal." Off-Road activities are not allowed; stay on improved roads and on your side of the road.
12. Use headlights and seatbelts at all times while traveling.
13. Speed limit is 35 MPH on mainline roads, less on spur roads and always subject to driving and weather conditions.
14. Please yield to logging traffic.
15. Do not block gates with vehicles. Vehicles blocking gates can/will be towed at owner's expense.
16. No firewood cutting or removal of forest product/floral greenery. The only exceptions are berries and mushrooms picked for personal consumption.
17. Report illegal activities to local law enforcement.
