



Weyerhaeuser Recreational Access Guidelines

Weyerhaeuser currently allows public access to our forestland, while making sure we can work safely, prevent damage to the environment, and safeguard company property. The following rules are in effect for **North Valley Operating area**, which includes the **Trask Tree Farm** in Yamhill County, the **Black Rock Tree Farm** in Polk County, the **Molalla Tree Farm** in Clackamas and Marion Counties the **Snow Peak Tree Farm** in Linn and Marion County and the **Vernonia Tree Farm** in Clatsop/Columbia/Washington Counties

- Access is allowed one hour before daylight and closes one hour after sunset.
- The privilege of entry may be revoked at any time, particularly during fire season.
- Fires and camping are prohibited
- Do not block gates or access.
- No dumping, littering or garbage hauling is allowed.
- No forest products may be removed without a permit, with exception of berry picking for personal use
- Stay out of logging and other active operational areas.
- Obey all posted signs
- Yield right of way to logging vehicles.
- No target shooting
- No alcohol beverages

When motorized vehicle access is allowed:

- All vehicles must be street legal. No ATVs, motorcycles or snowmobiles.
- Stay on improved, gravel roads. Use of dirt roads and spurs is prohibited.
- Use headlights and seat belts at all times.
- Maximum speed is 25 M.P.H. or slower depending on road conditions

Recreational Maps for Snow Peak, may be purchased at 34904 Brewster Road, Lebanon OR 97355 during normal business hours for \$15/map.
